BIOGRAPHY

As President and CEO, Kelly Vlahakis-Hanks leads the strategy and production of environmentally friendly cleaning products at ECOS. She oversees four geographically diverse facilities across the U.S. as well as a European manufacturing platform. She has been widely recognized for her highly effective leadership at ECOS and her influential voice in the green movement, corporate social responsibility, and sustainable manufacturing.

Vlahakis-Hanks received her undergraduate degree at UCLA and an MBA at Chapman University Argyros School of Business and Economics. She has been featured on CNN, CBS News, ABC News, FOX News, NBC News, Bloomberg and MarketWatch and in publications such as Fortune, Entrepreneur and the Los Angeles Times. She has received many awards for her sustainable leadership, including Entrepreneur Magazine's 100 Powerful Women in 2020 and Conscious Company's World-Changing Women in Conscious Business.

Vlahakis-Hanks resides in southern California with her husband Eric Hanks, an acclaimed African American art gallerist, their teenage daughter, and rescue dog.



MY JOURNEY

Growing up in a small town in Illinois (pop. 3000), I was raised with a passion to protect our beautiful, shared planet and all its inhabitants. When I was 18, I was accepted to UCLA as a Regents Scholar and pursued a double major in Communications and History – an education heightened by study abroad programs in my ancestral homelands of Greece and Africa.

Upon graduating, my first job was at the California African American Museum where I curated an exhibit on South African apartheid. I later honed my communications skills working for PR agencies, consumer goods companies, and art galleries. But it was after my tenure as the Executive Director of the American Hellenic Council of California, where I lobbied Congress on issues affecting global peace and stability, democracy, and human rights, that I saw an opportunity to help grow my family's green cleaning products company.

After I joined ECOS in 2003, I helped our company increase distribution with conventional and natural retailers, build multiple sustainable facilities across the nation, and create an authentic connection with consumers. Today, our business has grown dramatically, and ECOS has become a worldwide leader in plant-powered cleaning and sustainable manufacturing.





Kelly Vlahakis-Hanks leads ECOS, a women-owned and minority-owned company. As a woman of Greek and African American ancestry who has made equity and inclusion central to ECOS's mission as a business for good, Kelly has created a corporate culture of diversity and empowerment with a company that is 64% BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, and People of Color) and a Executive Team that is 40% BIPOC and 60% female. Her innovation and Technical Teams are over 60% female, which reflects her strong support of women in STEM fields. She has built a company that not only reflects the diversity of America but leads the cleaning products industry in equity and inclusion.





VISION

Kelly has had a lifelong passion for human and planetary wellness, which is reflected in ECOS's mission "to protect the health and wellness of people, pets and the planet by creating the most authentic, sustainable and affordable cleaning product for all."

From fighting for social and environmental justice to creating a Climate Positive company that regenerates more natural resources than it uses, Kelly has created a company that upholds the values that she holds most dear: truth, transparency and justice.

Kelly is an active member of several boards, including the **XPRIZE Foundation,the Chapman University** Board of Governors, where she serves on the Diversity Task Force, and the **UCLA Stavros Niarchos Foundation**. She is an active member of the **American Sustainable Business Network** where she sponsors the Companies for Safer Chemicals coalition to fight for legislation that supports safer consumer products and ingredient disclosure.

Kelly is also is a member of **YPO** (Young Presidents' Organization) and **Abundance 360**, a select community of executives and entrepreneurs using exponential technologies to transform their businesses.

As CEO, Kelly leads ECOS's sponsorships of the **American Cancer Society**, **Folds of Honor**, and many other charitable organizations. Under Kelly's direction, ECOS has donated over \$1 million to **Seattle Children's Hospital** through the Friends of Costco Guild. ECOS also donates every year to **Camp Korey**, one of Paul Newman's Serious Fun camps, which brings joy to children living with life-altering medical conditions and their families in a fun, safe camp environment with specialized medical support.




